Privacy Policy

Effective November 10, 2007

Information we collect

Everyone who completes the CDS Instructor Training receives a Facilitator Manual, and is asked to sign a copyright agreement that states the conditions for use of CDS intellectual property. From that agreement we collect the following information:

- Name
- Agency Name
- Address
- Phone Number, Fax Number, and E-mail Address
- Your designation as an 1) Individual Professional or 2) Institutional Professional

We also receive requests from members of the general public to be added to our list of Subscribers, who receive from time to time, e-mail notices of upcoming events of special interest to the CDS community. From those requests, we collect an e-mail address, and any other contact information volunteered by the Subscriber.

Uses of this personal information

The information is restricted in use for professional purposes only, including:

1. To publicize CDS workshops, trainings, and other events of special interest to the CDS community.
2. To respond to legitimate, responsible requests for the contact information of CDS Instructors.
3. To communicate with CDS clients and customers regarding CDS products and services.

If we propose to use personal information for any purposes other than those described in this Policy, we will offer you an effective way to opt out of the use of personal information for those other purposes. We will not collect or use personal information for purposes other than those described in this Policy, unless we have obtained your prior consent.

Information sharing

This information is stored solely in the CDS database and is not shared with any other entity without your consent, except under the following circumstances:

We have a good faith belief that access, use, preservation, or disclosure of such information is reasonably necessary to (a) satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process, or enforceable government request, (b) enforce applicable parameters, including investigation of potential violations thereof, (c) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues, or (d) protect against imminent harm to the rights, property, or safety of CDS, its users or the public as required or permitted by law.

Information Security

We take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure, or destruction of personal data.

We restrict access to personal information to CDS employees, contractors, and agents who need to know that information in order to operate, develop, or improve our services. These individuals are bound by confidentiality obligations and may be subject to discipline, including termination and criminal prosecution, if they fail to meet these obligations.

Data integrity

CDS processes personal information only for the purposes for which it was collected and in accordance with this Policy. We review our data collections, storage, and processing practices to ensure that we only collect, store, and process the personal information needed to provide or improve our services. We take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we process is accurate, complete, and current, but we depend on our users to update or correct their personal information whenever necessary.

Accessing and updating personal information

We make good faith efforts to provide you with access to your personal information and either to correct this data if it is inaccurate or to delete such data at your request if it is not otherwise required to be retained by law or for legitimate business purposes. We ask individual users to identify themselves and the information requested to be accessed, corrected, or removed before processing such requests, and we may decline to process requests that are unreasonably repetitive or systematic, require disproportionate technical effort, jeopardize the privacy of others, or would be extremely impractical (for instance, requests concerning information residing on backup tapes), or for which access is not otherwise required. In any case where we provide information access and correction, we perform this service free of charge, except if doing so would require a disproportionate effort.

Enforcement

CDS intermittently reviews its compliance with this Policy.
